Dr Kelly specializes in the care of bone and soft tissue tumors, limb reconstruction after tumor removal, bone healing problems and osteonecrosis (avascular necrosis). Currently, she also serves as the Medical Director of the Osteonecrosis and Sarcoma Service Lines at the Institute for Limb Preservation at Presbyterian St. Luke's Medical Center. She is nationally recognized for her work on surgical procedures for treating osteonecrosis and continues to conduct research. She has been published widely on bone and soft tissue tumors.
